• U.S. fuel supplies tighten as energy pipeline outage enters fifth day

Supplies of gasoline tightened further in parts of the United States as the shutdown of the nation's biggest fuel pipeline by hackers entered its fifth day, raising concern about price spikes at the pumps heading into the summer driving season.

• OPEC sticks to 2021 oil demand growth forecast despite Indian COVID crisis

OPEC stuck to its prediction of a strong recovery in world oil demand in 2021 as growth in China and the United States counters the coronavirus crisis in India, an outlook that bolsters the group's plan to gradually ease output cuts.

• Tesla puts brake on Shanghai land buy as U.S.-China tensions weigh - sources

U.S. electric car maker Tesla has halted plans to buy land to expand its Shanghai plant and make it a global export hub, people familiar with the matter said, due to uncertainty created by U.S.-China tensions.

• Tech giants join call for funding U.S. chip production

Some of the world's biggest chip buyers, including Apple, Microsoft and Alphabet's Google, are joining top chip-makers such as Intel to create a new lobbying group to press for government chip manufacturing subsidies.

Couche-Tard prices \$1 billion debt offering, including inaugural green bonds

Canadian convenience store operator Alimentation Couche-Tard said on Monday that it has priced a \$1 billion debt offering, including inaugural green bonds.

BEFORE THE BELL

Futures for **Canada's main stock index** fell, hit by a drop in **oil** prices as the rapid spread of COVID-19 infections in India raised concerns about demand. **Wall Street futures** were down, and **world stocks** tumbled, as investors feared latest reading on the U.S. inflation, due for release on Wednesday, could prompt the Federal Reserve to rethink its monetary policy stance. China's anti-monopoly crackdown also added to the sell-off in technology shares. The **U.S. dollar** was weak, while **gold** steadied.

STOCKS TO WATCH

• Alimentation Couche-Tard Inc: The Canadian convenience store operator said on Monday that it has priced a \$1 billion debt offering, including inaugural green bonds. Green bonds are a category of fixed-income securities that raise capital for projects with environmental benefits, such as renewable energy or low-carbon transport. The private debt offering included a \$350 million aggregate principal amount of 3.625% senior unsecured notes due 2051, referred to by the company as the green bonds. The statement from Couche-Tard did not disclose further pricing details of the overall bond sale.



INSIGHT

Market at odds with Fed as inflation expectations hit 10-year highs

U.S. inflation expectations have surged to the highest in a decade as the economy reopens from COVID-19-related shutdowns, putting investors at odds with the Federal Reserve which sees price pressures still far from its target.

ANALYSTS' RECOMMENDATION

- Cenovus Energy Inc: ATB Capital Markets cuts target price to C\$15.25 from C\$16, anticipating increased capital expenses for 2022 and beyond.
- **KP Tissue Inc**: CIBC cuts target price to C\$11 from C\$12, to reflect less visibility on the extent of industry mitigation efforts and mixed signals by large branded tissue producers in the U.S.
