· Labor dispute stops Canadian canola oil, forestry exports from West Coast

Canada's exports of canola oil and forest products from West Coast ports have halted due to a labor dispute, producers said on Thursday. The stoppage, which started on Monday, involves limited strike action by the longshore foremen and a full lockout of Local 514 of the International Longshore and Warehouse Union by the B.C. Maritime Employers Association.

· Alberta dismisses provincial pension manager's entire board, citing low returns

Canada's main crude-producing province Alberta dismissed the Alberta Investment Management Corp's entire board on Thursday, saying the pension manager had underdelivered returns from the investments of provincial government funds it manages.

Walmart to offer independent drivers new holiday bonuses in battle with Amazon

Walmart will pay independent delivery drivers new financial incentives to pick up online orders at its U.S. stores and deliver them to shoppers during the holiday season, the retailer told Reuters.

· Boeing to repay furloughed staff, proceed with job cuts

Boeing CEO Kelly Ortberg said on Thursday that employees furloughed during a seven-week strike by factory workers would be repaid by the company for lost wages, but it would proceed with plans to cut about 10% of its global workforce.

• Rivian reassures investors with cost cuts, green credit sales amid weak EV demand

Rivian said on Thursday it was on track to turn a gross profit in the fourth quarter helped by cost cuts and a sharp increase in sales of green car credits, despite a parts shortage disrupting production and weak EV demand.

BEFORE THE BELL

Futures tied to **Canada's main stock index** slipped, hurt by losses in **crude** prices, while investors shifted their focus to key domestic jobs data due later in the day. **U.S. stock index futures** took a breather after a sharp rally, powered by a sweeping Trump win and an expected interest-rate cut, took the **S&P 500 futures** above the 6,000 mark for the first time. **European shares** inched down on the back of mixed earnings results. Meanwhile, **Nikkei** secured its biggest weekly gain since late September. **China** and **Hong Kong stocks** declined but booked their best week in a month, as investors lowered expectations for Beijing's fiscal stimulus package and took profit ahead of the announcement. Separately, the **U.S. dollar** was on track for ending a volatile week with a slight gain. **Gold** prices retreated and were on track for their biggest weekly fall in over five months.

Is Goldilocks gone? Emerging markets face uncertain path under Trump

Investors hoping for a "Goldilocks" moment for emerging markets in 2025 following years of global interest rate hikes are grappling with significant uncertainty ahead of Donald Trump's impending return to the White House.
